On the other hand, Critical Information Infrastructure (CII) host and support critical information and (tele)communication networks that encompass mobile telephony and internet access services. Hence any disruption or destruction (in a worst-case-scenario) of them can undoubtedly result in dire consequences to the public

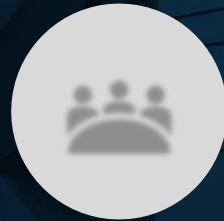
